

Fundraising Specific Events Agreement

The following is an excerpt of the USAREUR Private Organizations (PO) and Fundraising Policy, which expired on December 1, 2003. The procedures and guidance contained in the excerpt continues to be the policy of the 98th ASG for conducting a bingo as a fundraiser. Prior to conducting a bingo, a PO or Informal Fund must review the following information, and date and sign where indicated below.

In addition to the information required in section III of the new USAREUR Private Organizations and Fundraising Policy, bingo games will be conducted as follows:

- a. The games will be self-supporting and the sponsoring PO will pay for merchandise prizes before the event or have cash on hand to pay for prizes. Neither the amount of prizes nor their awarding will be based on income generated by the bingo game.

- b. Suitable controls will be established (including security of bingo cards, verification of winning cards, and a check of admission tickets).

- c. Bingo prizes may be in cash or merchandise. One jackpot prize of \$500 or less may be given during one event. If the jackpot prize is not won, however, a consolation prize of \$150 or less may be awarded.
