SUBJECT: Suspension of DoDDS School Bus Privileges

1. REFERENCES:

- a. DODEA Regulation 2051.1, Disciplinary Rules and Procedures
- b. Army Regulation 58-1, Management, Acquisition, and Use of Motor Vehicles
- c. Army in Europe Regulation 27-9, Misconduct by Civilians

2. PURPOSE: To outline policy for use of military shuttle busses by DoDDS students during school hours.

3. SCOPE: This policy applies to all DoDDS students within the 417th Base Support Battalion (BSB) Area of Operations (AOR).

4. POLICY:

a. Students whose school bus riding privileges are suspended will not use community shuttle bus services to circumvent a DoDDS suspension. Parents of DoDDS students are responsible for getting their student family members to and from school IAW school arrival and departure policies when the student's school bus riding privileges are suspended. Community shuttle bus services are provided primarily to transport Soldiers and DOD employees between offices and work areas.

b. Parents and students violating this policy may face adverse action under the UCMJ or Civilian Misconduct regulation.
