SUBJECT: Quiet Hours and Curfew Policy

1. **REFERENCE:** Local German Ordinances, USAREUR Child Supervision Policy
2. **PURPOSE:** To establish "quiet hours" and a curfew throughout the 417th BSB military community.
3. **SCOPE:** Applies to all military personnel, family members, guests, and German nationals who reside in or pass through military housing areas.
4. **POLICY:**

- a. Quiet Hours.

(1) "Quiet hours" extend from 2200-0600 in the 417th BSB German/American military communities. Loud noises are prohibited during this time. Examples of prohibited activities include mowing lawns, using power tools, hammering, woodworking, allowing dogs to bark for extended periods, playing radios, TVs, or tape players at such volume as to disturb others, conducting picnics or parties outside or on balconies, playing and/or practicing of unit athletic teams (softball/flag football) in housing or picnic areas, riding toys such as "big wheels" and shouting, screaming, or general roughhousing by individuals and groups.

(2) There will be no cadence calling within 100 meters of family housing or German residential areas. Soldiers may not conduct physical training adjacent to or inside residential areas, on or off post.

(3) The only exception to the "quiet hours" is sounding of alarms in cases of emergency.

(4) The establishment of "quiet hours" does not imply that noise restrictions are non-existent during other times of the day. Excessive noise that disturbs neighbors is prohibited at all times.

This policy supersedes policy # 10-7, dated 13 November 2003, and remains in effect until rescinded or superseded.

(5) Housing occupants and area/building coordinators are required to enforce this policy in a friendly and neighborly manner. Military police will be called only when violators fail to respond to occupant and coordinator suggestions. Military police will cite offenders for non-compliance with this policy. For repeated violations, sponsors may be subject to adverse administrative action to include termination of government quarters and early return of family members to CONUS.

b. Curfew

(1) A curfew for all juveniles under the age of 16 will extend from 2200-0600 daily. During that time, juveniles must be accompanied by an adult if outside. This does not include special events properly chaperoned such as Club Beyond or High School dances and activities.

(2) Military police will cite offenders for non-compliance with this policy. For repeated violations, sponsors may be subject to adverse administrative action to include termination of government quarters and early return of family members to CONUS.
