- 1. Reception - people to help guide donors into the system and to explain procedures.
- 2. Physical/Vitals - 2-4 medics/nurses
- 3. Bag Issue - one person to work with a staff member in assigning blood bags to donors.
- 4. Phlebotomy – two people (who are not put off by working with blood) to carry full blood bags
- 5. Processing - two people (as in #4 above) to work with staff in processing completed donations.
- 6. Recovery - two people to take care of the recovery/cookie area. Their job is twofold:
 1. to keep the snacks and drinks stocked and available to donors after their donation.
 2. to watch the donors, for ten to fifteen minutes following their donation, for signs of donor reactions.

Volunteers will work on shifts from 0830 to 1300 and from 1300 to 1700
