



From A-3 take the exit towards Kitzingen. Go to Richthofenstrasse and take a right. This will be the first traffic light you reach after exiting A-3. Drive through the next traffic light. **Follow road until second light. Turn right. The old bridge will be right in front of you. Turn right onto the road before the bridge. Take an immediate left and you are in the parking lot. The concert is located directly ahead under the "Old Main River Bridge."**

From A-7 exit onto B-8 going to Kitzingen. Proceed on this road until you cross the Main River. Once across the river take the first left onto Mainbernheimerstrasse. Drive until you reach the construction area. Follow the Umleitung signs right onto Fulgplatzstasse, then left onto Obere Neue Gasse. Follow this until it dead ends into Richthofen-Strasse. Turn left Follow instructions highlighted in bold above.




# Child-Supervision Policy

➤ **Updated Policy Issued 18 June 2004 states that:**

**Children in the 5th grade and below must have adult supervision at all times;**

**Children in the sixth grade may baby-sit siblings over 2 years old for up to 3 hours if they have ready access to adult supervision.**



# Vehicle Issues

- **Visitors Operating a U'R plated Vehicle**
  - Must see the Customs office for exception to policy**
  - Must have an International Driver's License issued from the U.S.**
- **Delinquent/expired registrations**
  - Operators risk suspension of driving privileges for at least 30 – 120 days per AR 190-1 para 3-23**



# Bicycle Safety

- **Properly wear approved helmet (on-post requirement)**
- **Ride on the right side of the road or designated path**
- **Have two reflectors 180 degrees apart**
- **During hours of darkness**
  - **Headlight emitting white light**
  - **Taillight emitting red light**
  - **Light color clothing or reflective accessories**
