HOURS OF OPERATIONS

The Front Desk is open Sunday – Thursday; 24 hours a day and Friday – Saturday from 0700-2400. To contact the Front Desk, dial “59” from the telephone in your room.

CHECKOUT TIME

1000 daily (late checkouts may be charged an additional night). Please lock your door upon your departure and return all keys to the Front Desk upon checkout. If you need to store your belongings please contact the front desk.

QUIET HOURS

The hotel quiet hours are from 2200-0600.

PROPERTY

Furnishings and fixtures must remain in rooms at all times. Each room has blow dryers, irons, and remote controls for the TV & VCR. Please remember guesthouse linen is only to be used for its intended purpose. Guests are liable for all damages and/or missing items.

HOUSEKEEPING

Housekeeping service is available daily from 0800-1530. If service is not needed in the room, please hang the “Do Not Disturb” sign on your door. If the “Do Not Disturb” sign remains on your door after 1300, no maid service will be received for that day. The following linens are provided by housekeeping;

1. Clean towels and washcloths (two sets per bed) are provided daily.
2. Bed linen will be changed twice a week.

In order to receive full maid service please assist housekeeping by storing all personal items in the wardrobe. Housekeepers will not remove personal items to vacuum, dust, or make beds.

VEHICLE

Washing, waxing, changing oil, etc., are not permitted in the Guesthouse parking areas. There are two Auto Craft Shops. One is on Larson Barracks, Building 18, MIL 355-2699 or CIV 09321-702699. The other one is in Giebelstadt at Army Air Field, Building 511, MIL 352-7225 or CIV 09334-877225. You will also find a German carwash located by BaWay outside the back gate of Leighton.

PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL ITEMS

The Guesthouse is not responsible for any items left in the rooms. Please use the safe in the wardrobe to store personal items. For instructions on the operation of the safe, see the information sheet located in this directory.

Guest Information

LAUNDRY FACILITIES

Washers and Dryers are available in the basements of buildings 2 and 3 between 0900-2200 daily. Vending machines with soap and bleach are also available in each basement.

DAMAGES

Damages caused by other than fair wear and tear or the unauthorized removal of property from the room warrants liability on the part of the guest. Prior approval from hotel management is needed to rearrange furniture in the rooms.

NEWSPAPERS

The Stars and Stripes newspaper is for sale outside the reception area in the vending machine.

VCR's & TV's

To watch movies, switch the television to "Video" by pressing the small button (labeled TV/Video) on the left of the power button located on the front of the television. This will switch the TV to the correct channel for watching videos. To watch TV, press the button again until the TV channels appear. If you have any questions please contact the front desk by dialing "59" from your phone.

PETS

Pets are only allowed in the hotel annex located in building #5. Pets must be in a kennel in order for housekeepers to clean your room. Please refer to the Commanders pet policy memo for pet walking areas.

BANKING/CURRENCY CONVERSIONS

There are two banks, Nations Bank and Andrews Federal Credit Union along with four ATM machines located at the following locations on Leighton Barracks; AAFES Theatre, Clothing Sales Store, AAFES Mega Mall Shopping Center and the 24 hour Shoppette. The Front Desk cannot convert currency, checks or traveler checks.

Voltage

Please remember that the voltage in the hotel is 220v, 50 cycles and appliances made for the US voltage 110v will not work. If the appliance is Dual Voltage, please contact the front desk for an adapter.

Internet access

A limited amount of modem adapters which allow you to connect your computer to the German telephone system are available. These adapters can be signed out at the front desk. Also available is access information to dial into the Army TermServer.

METHOD OF PAYMENT

Our facility accepts cash, personal checks (for the total amount of charges), MasterCard, Discover, Visa, and American Express.

Other conditions shown on the registration receipt and those posted in rooms also apply while occupying the Army Lodging Facility.

TLA

For guests who are in an Official PCS status, for finance to reimburse the hotel for your room charges, they require 5 copies of the following:

- ◆ TLA statement covering the days you have occupied Army Lodging Würzburg. TLA statements are picked up from the 417th Housing Office in Kitzingen. Please ensure that all dependants are listed on the statement.
- ◆ Complete orders with all dependants listed by name.

For dual military guests, both documents are required for each military member.

For PCS-In guests, housing issues TLA statements at when you sign for housing.

All PCS out guests checking out without the required paperwork or have stayed in the hotel on days not covered by TLA are responsible for the room charges upon checkout and will be individually billed.

If you have any questions on TLA procedures, the front desk will be happy to explain the procedures and necessary paperwork required. You may contact the front desk by dialing “59” from the phone in your room.

Clock Radio Alarm Instructions

Sony

- To set the alarm, first tune in a radio station and adjust the volume.
- While holding down the **ALARM A RADIO** (for the radio) or **ALARM B BUZZER** (for the buzzer), press either + or – under **TIME SET** until the desired time appears in the display.
- When you release the **ALARM A** or **B**, the **ALARM A** or **B** indicator stops flashing and lights up and the current time appears in the display.
- The alarm will come on at the preset time, and automatically shut off after 59 minutes.
- If you set **ALARM A** or **B** at the same time, only **ALARM A** will work.
- To shut off the alarm, press **RADIO OFF/ALARM RESET/OFF**. The alarm will come on at the preset time the next day.
- To cancel either alarm, while holding down the **ALARM A** or **B** button, press **RADIO OFF/ALARM RESET/OFF**
- To doze for a few more minutes, press the **SNOOZE/DATE/SLEEP OFF**. The alarm will shut off, but will come on again in about 6 minutes. You can repeat this process as long as you like.
- To check the preset time, press **ALARM A** or **B**.
- To set the current time, while holding down **CLOCK**, press the + or – under **TIME SET** until the correct time appears in the display.

Panasonic

- To set the alarm, first tune in a radio station and adjust the volume.
- While pressing the **ALARM DISP/CANCEL**, set the desired alarm time by pressing the **HOUR** or **MIN** button until the desired time is displayed.
- If you press the **HOUR** and **MIN** simultaneously while pressing the **ALARM DISPLAY/CANCEL** button, the clock display returns to 00:00.
- Set the **SELECTOR** to **RADIO**, or **BUZZER**.
- The alarm will activate at the desired time and automatically shut off in 2 hours.
- To shut the alarm off before 2 hours, press the **ALARM DISPLAY/CANCEL** button
- The alarm will activate at the same time every day. To turn off the alarm, move the **SELECTOR** switch to off.
- To set the time, press the **TIME SET** button, and then the **HOUR** or **MIN**

GE

- To set the alarm, first tune in a radio station by sliding the **FUNCTION SELECTOR** to **on** and adjust the volume and slide the **FUNCTION SELECTOR** to **OFF**.
- Press and hold the **WAKE** button and use the **HOUR** or **MIN** buttons to set the desired AM or PM wake up time.
- Release the **WAKE** button, and the current time is again displayed
- Slide the **FUNCTION SELECTOR** to **MUSICWAKE** or **ALARMWAKE** accordingly.
- The alarm will activate at the desired time and automatically shut off in 2 hours.
- The alarm will activate at the same time every day.
- To turn off the alarm, slide the **FUNCTION SELECTOR** to **OFF**.

In Room Safes

All rooms in Würzburg have an in room safe which is located in the wardrobe. The following instructions are for setting your personal code as well as opening and closing your safe. If you have any questions, please contact the front desk by dialing “59” from your phone.

To set your personal combination:

1. Push the “M” button (Located on the backside of the safe door)
2. Push the “1” button
3. Push the “#” button
4. Push in your personal code (must be at least 4 numbers, but not more than 16)
5. Push the “#” button again

To open or close the safe:

1. Push the “C” button
2. Put in your personal code
3. Push the “#” button
4. Turn the knob to open or close then pull or push the door open or closed, while the melody is playing

In the event you have put in the wrong code 5 times, the safe will lock up and the keyboard will not allow any more attempts. Once this happens, follow the steps to open or close the safe twice with the correct code to open the safe. You may also call the front desk by dialing “59” from your phone, and a maintenance employee will assist you in opening the safe.

When you are ready to check out of your room, please leave the safe door open

Located downtown this is the farthest distance recommendation, but the unique experience of this restaurant is worth checking out.

There was a nice selection of meals available. The most popular are the steaks, ribs, BBQ chicken, and fajitas.

Since SAM'S has a buzz about the unusual way they serve their steaks on hot stones we ordered steaks to participate in the experience. What an interesting technique to serve steak. It is served raw on an extremely hot marble type of stone; you slice the meat and cook it yourself on this hot stone. It comes with three different sauces for dipping, nice hot soft bread and a salad. In addition to our steak, we ordered a baked potato, which was delicious too.

This place is not recommended for families with young children, these stones are too dangerous to have children around. But would highly recommend to adults looking to have a wonderful meal with great atmosphere with the ability to have a conversation with out being drowned with background noise.

The staff and service was quick, friendly and courteous.

- Continue across highway B19
- At the next major intersection, after crossing B19, make a right onto Martin-Luther Strasse.

- Haugerring will turn into Rontgenring.
