



Preparing for the Re-accreditation process

The Kitzingen SAS staff is proud to inform you that it is time to begin our national school age re-accreditation process. This process is a self-assessing, self-improving process to raise the quality of our school age program. Our assessments and improvements will be endorsed by the National After School Association to insure the maintenance of the quality program initially accredited at our school age program May 2001.

We will be visited by endorsers of NAA to observe and verify our programs quality. They will endorse our level of program quality or give us feedback on areas for improvement.

The process of self-assessment and improvement is:

1. Notification and Preparation of our community, parents and children.
2. Recruit ASQ team (in-house accreditation team)
3. Submit and compile data from Family, Staff and Child Surveys.
4. ASQ team trained on the observation tool and then observe KSAS.
5. All data is compiled and entered to the Self-Study Summary tool.
6. Using data from self-summary tool the ASQ team will develop an action plan for improvements and the timeline to make

the improvements

7. Once improvements are made all surveys and observations are resubmitted and entered on self-study summary. When ASQ team determines that program is ready Application of re-accreditation is submitted.

We are asking for 3 or 4 parents who are interested in assisting us in the process of re-accreditation please see the KSAS Director Veronica Bischoff if you are interested. Please assist us by providing feedback for improvement, attending PAC meetings or joining our ASQ team.

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
